Often medical care in regards to evacuations can come from a distance and be expensive.

In order to better serve our constituents in many regions where our events are taking place we have reached out to **Life Flight Network**. Life Flight also has many rotor-wing bases in Eastern Oregon (Ontario, La Grande), and Western Idaho (Boise, Mountain Home, Lewiston, Pocatello & Sandpoint). Fire Med: Fire Med member households are covered by over 80 Fire Med affiliates located throughout the state of Oregon (La Grande, Enterprise, Baker City, Prineville, Redmond, Sisters and throughout the Western-side cities & towns in Oregon.)

We asked **Life Flight** to partner with us to encourage our constituents to consider joining the organization in order to receive emergency medical transport by either air or ground during one of our events.
